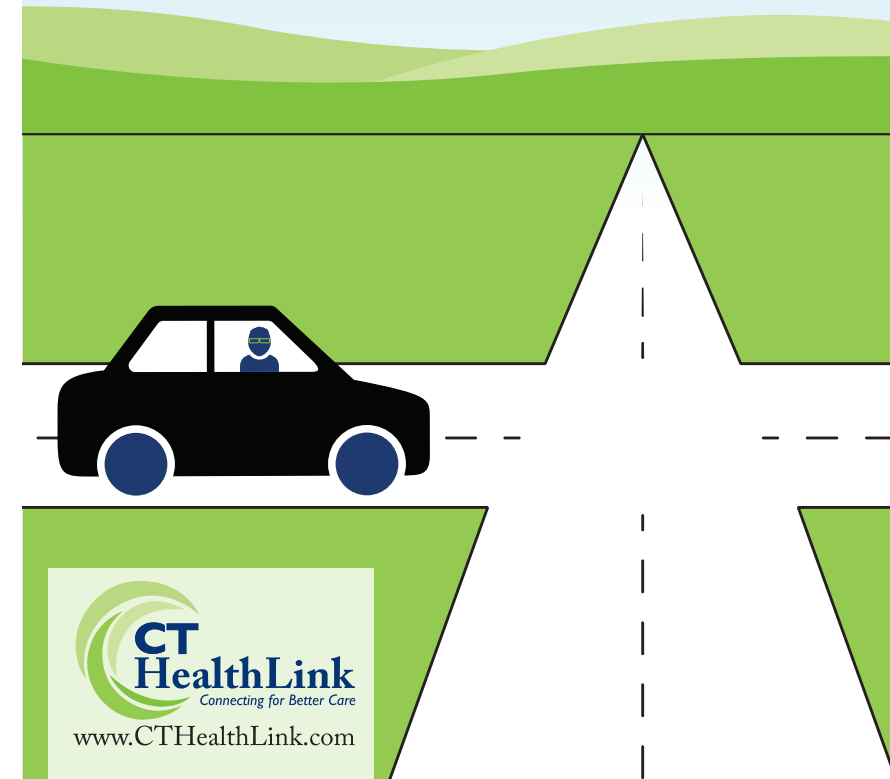
lab results, medications, etc., in an effort to deliver you the most efficient and thorough services possible.

A patient may at any time decide to opt-out from having health records shared through the health information network. For more information visit www.CTHHealthLink.com.



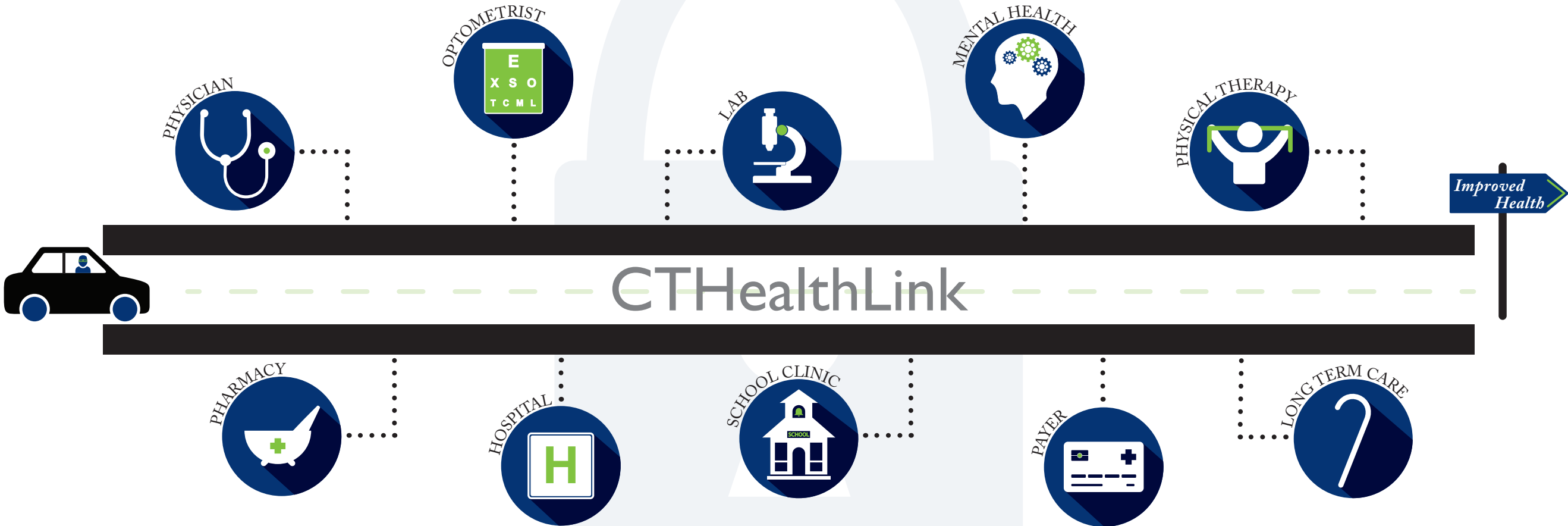

Taking the CTHHealthLink Route



The information that is shared through the secure network may include health information related to treatment from all participating healthcare providers who are connected to the network, providing the most complete patient record available. This may include information about your diagnoses, procedures, allergies, test results such as x-rays or laboratory, and prescribed medications. Such information may

include sensitive health information ("Sensitive Information", i.e., mental health information, HIV/AIDS, genetic information and test results, alcohol and drug abuse treatment information other than alcohol and drug abuse treatment information subject to 42 C.F.R.
